# HAMILTON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING MINUTES

# **OCTOBER 2, 2023**

Francis Snyder raised concerns about increased nighttime gun club activity. Ronald L. Weidner advised Francis to file a formal complaint with the township's zoning officer, who will investigate and consider actions toward reducing the club's activity.
